

# The Battle of Hohenlinden, 3 December 1800

## SCENARIO RULES for *AGE OF EAGLES*

### THE FIRST TURN

All units have a +4 on the reserve movement table on the first turn.

### TERRAIN

- 1) All woods and hills are rough terrain.
- 2) All streams are fordable by infantry, cavalry and commanders but may only be crossed by artillery at bridges.
- 3) There are two kinds of roads, primary and secondary. Primary roads are treated just as usual. Secondary roads allow units in road column ignore terrain penalties and move as if in clear terrain. There is no other road bonus for secondary roads.
- 4) Built up areas confer a -2 on the firing chart and give units defending in them a +2 in close action for favorable ground. Woods are -1 for firing and give the defender a +1 for favorable ground.

## THE ARMIES

### FRENCH

- 1) The French army infantry is categorized as “columnar”, has a basic movement rate of 14” and fires 1 point per stand out to 6”. French infantry receives a +1 on the march table in all cases. French artillery fires on the French table (of course.)
- 2) Some of the French figures we have are armored (cuirassier) cavalry. The French Army did not operate cuirassiers at this time so these are regarded as heavy cavalry only.

### AUSTRIAN

- 1) The Austrian/Bavarian army infantry is “linear”, with a basic movement rate of 10”. Austrian and German allied infantry fires 2 points per stand out to 3” only except for those very few skirmish capable units, which can fire 1 point out to 6” additionally. Austrian artillery fires on the “other” table.
- 2) Note that Austrian artillery can only deploy and unlimber if the corps commanders or army commanders are within command radius and/or if the batteries are attached to brigades. There is no intermediate command structure.
- 3) The Austrian attachment rule is in force. It reads essentially that Austrian commanders can only attach to a brigade after they roll a 7 or less.
